VETERAN (7-9YRS) 5-2 ABS.

 Soft masculine head on this 7 year old boy, good dark eye and stop. Good length
 Of neck into well placed shoulders, angles balanced fore and aft, good depth of brisket , all
 Standing on well boned legs and neat feet, moved round the ring with good drive and forward
 reach holding a level topline and correct tail carriage which won him this class today. **RBVIS**

2nd. Macdonald Sh Ch Lamancha in Search of Pye JW Shcm Another lovely dog in pale
Coat, with good head proportions, equal angles, good depth of rib and short couplings,
Straight front and well let down hocks. Well presented coat. Moved out well, but just preferred tail
carriage of first today.

3rd Wurft – Murdocks Leaving Las Vegas

MINOR PUPPY (6 - 1ABS)

A couple of pups in this class I thought were carrying a little too much weight hence my placings.

1ST Golder – Gembaek's Play That Funky Music (imp) NAF TAF 7 month old baby just right for his age, well balanced at this stage with good head piece dark eye and pigment, well set on neck into correctly angled forehand which corresponded with his turn of stifle. Moved out holding his topline well for one so young.
2nd Phipps – Baker & Baker –Maddouse Rollercoaster – This young man is going to take time to fill his slightly larger frame, but a lovely pup to go over, he has balanced

angles, soft masculine head and a topline held well, with the tail coming straight of his back. 3rd – Watkins – LOOK FOR A STAR AT GILLBRYAN TAF NAF

<u>PUPPY – (4-1ABS)</u>

1ST - GRAINGER – Amilone Flintstone – Loved this young man thought he had the most appealing masculine head, he is well up to size and stands on well boned legs and neat catlike feet. His neck flows into well placed shoulders, level topline leading to a correctly turned stifle. He moved with good reach and drive carrying the tail correctly.

JUNIOR - (11 - 2ABS)

1ST WALLINGTON – Wynrita School Daze - Dog of good proportions who I thought
 Stood out in this class, he has a super head piece with good dark eye, correct dentition.
 Strong muscular neck with good reach into shoulders placed correctly, good spring of rib
 Firm level topline , moved out with drive.

2nd Swatton's – Alibren Baker's Boy – Another lovely dog again with the most appealing head, ample neck corresponding angles and super topline and correct tailset.
Stands four square on good feet. Just felt his coat was not quite that of the 1st placed dog.

Ample well muscled neck leading to correctly placed shoulders with Corresponding angles, nice depth of rib leading to a strong well made rear. Moved with a good stride, well turned stifle all standing on catlike feet. Presented in beautiful coat and condition.

 2^{nd} Archer's – Haydengold Rock Star at Sunandair JW – Another nice boy, not quite the Finish of coat of the 1^{st} placed dog, but good head with dark eye and pigment, clean neck well angled fore placing legs well under body, with corresponding rear angles. Moved straight coming and going.

 Strong rear quarters used well on the move. Considered for RCC .

He is not a Big boy but has an appealing head with soft expression, he stands four square on good legs and Feet, with balanced angles. He moved out well

SPECIAL OPEN FOR HOLDERS OF SHOW/GUNDOG WORKING CERTIFICATE (4 - 1ABS)

1ST – NEIL – GILDAS AMORI INFINITI – This young man just took my eye when he went round the ring. He has a chiselled head with dark eye and pigment, strong neck into a well placed shoulders, good layback and corresponding upper arm, well sprung rib level topline and tailset, correctly turned stifle with well let down hocks, all used to advantage on the move which won him this class.

2nd Kloek – MESSANO YIN OR YANG – This boy was reserve in a strong Post. Grad. Class. Slightly Heavier built boy but very nicely put together which was evident when I went over him, he has a good head and neck leading to a firm topline. He has balanced angles, deep brisket and correct body proportions. Just preferred movement of 1st.
